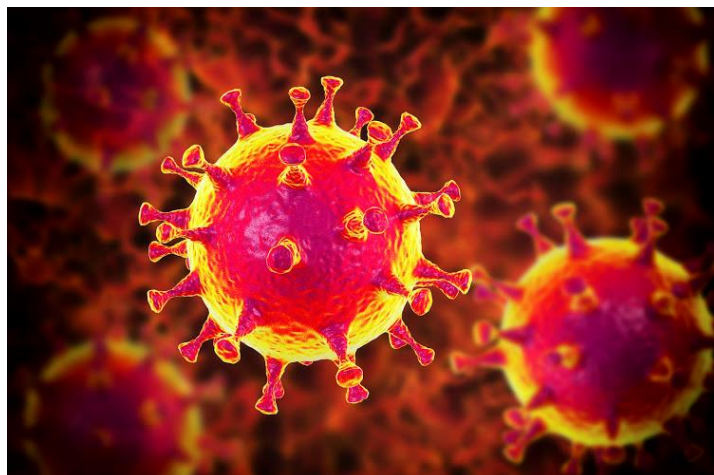
Geagte Ouers / Dear Parents
